

Mobile-friendly FAFSA® Website

The fafsa.gov website fits the screen size and shape of any device, including desktop or laptop computers and mobile devices such as smartphones or tablets. You can complete the FAFSA form on a mobile device with the same ease as on a desktop or laptop computer.

prior to Sept. 29, you must update the app to access the 2020–21 FAFSA® form.

The 2020–21 *Free Application for Federal Student Aid* (FAFSA®) form is available to students and parents to complete through the myStudentAid mobile app and the fafsa.gov website.

myStudentAid Mobile App

You can complete the 2020–21 FAFSA form using the myStudentAid app. Download the myStudentAid app in the [Apple App Store](#) (iOS) or the [Google Play](#) store (Android). The myFAFSA component—which is used to complete the FAFSA form—is one of the app’s featured functions. **Note:** If you downloaded the app prior to Sept. 29, you must update the app to access the 2020–21 FAFSA® form.
