Required vaccinations:

1. Hep B-3 shot series-Must at least be initiated with proof of initiation and/or completion. If you cannot produce a shot record, you must get a titer.
2. Tdap- must show proof per shot record, no expiration
3. MMR-must show proof per shot record, no expiration
4. Flu-have proof of shot by the November 1, 2021. If a student refuses for any reason must wear a mask during the flu season if the student is within 3 feet of a client. Flu shots should be available around October or November.
5. TB-Must have shot record that proves coverage for the school year. Must cover through May 31, 2022. If a student refuses for any reason, the student must get a chest x-ray and have proof of clear x-ray.

**Vaccinations must be finished and/or initiated by September 1, 2021, or above guidelines.**

**I understand that not completing the required vaccinations and above rules by the deadline means that I will not be allowed in the clinical setting. The vaccination regimen complies with the clinical site's policies.**

Institutional Refund Policy

When a student withdraws, drops, or for some reason fails to complete a period of enrollment for which they have been charged they are to submit a written request for a refund to HPTC. HPTC will calculate what, if any, refund needs to be made. Refunds for students receiving a Pell Grant will be calculated according to the Department of Education's "Return of Title IV Funds" regulation. This regulation requires a calculation based on the actual percentage of the enrollment period the student attended, and will, in many cases, require a return of a portion of the monies received by both the institution and the student. High Plains Technology Center will charge the student for any monies that the school must return to Pell if the student is dropped or withdraws.

I fully understand that if I should drop out of school for any reason after the refund policy has been taken into consideration, I will be responsible for any outstanding balance regarding tuition. Should I be attending school funded by a financial aid agency and the agency is unable to pay the balance of my account due to lack of satisfactory progress, absenteeism, incomplete paperwork in financial aid office, default of a previous student loan at any institution, or all legal federal funds have already been disbursed, I will be responsible for paying that balance.
